Project Information

Description: Volunteers are asked to Bead necklaces and bracelets. This is a project that is sure to appeal to young people, and promises to be not only educational and creative, but lots of fun, for boys and girls alike, as well as any adults who accompany them. Previous projects have been an extremely positive experience for the students, who admired their own handiwork, and rightfully so. Each student took home at least one piece of jewelry, and the rest of the pieces were sold around town, for donations for the benefit of the Sanctuary. Imagine That, a bead store in Ormond Beach, generously has donated the beads for the project. In addition, Let's Talk Beads, a new bead store in Bunnell, has also agreed to partner with Pig Tales on this project.

Who will benefit: The funds that are raised from selling these necklaces and bracelets will be used to help finance construction and/or repair of pig shelters, fencing, other ongoing projects, as well as feed and vet bills at the Sanctuary. There are approximately 600 pigs, many chickens, a goat, two dogs, two cats, and three horses.

Long Term Impact: This project will inspire young people to get involved in helping in the community, especially our beloved animal friends. Those who participate will experience the joy that accompanies volunteering time and energy to help others, human and animal alike. The artistry involved in creating unique jewelry will generate a desire to learn more about this fascinating craft. The participants will quickly experience a sense of pride and satisfaction as they complete their treasures.
